



Guidelines for 2015 Annual Conference bursaries

There are a limited number of bursaries available of £250 each to support attendance of the 2015 AVTRW conference at the Royal Veterinary College, 2-3rd September – these are available for students, interns or residents at UK/Irish veterinary schools (Glasgow, Edinburgh, London, Liverpool, Bristol, Nottingham, Cambridge, Surrey, Dublin) and UK veterinary sciences research institutes (the Pirbright Institute, Moredun, Animal and Plant Health Agency, the Roslin Institute, Scotland's Rural College, James Hutton Institute).

Eligibility requirements for these bursaries are:

- Registration as a student, intern or resident (proof will be required before bursary is awarded).
- Abstract submitted and accepted for oral presentation or poster at the conference.

If multiple applicants are eligible from the same institution, selection of the bursary recipient(s) will be made by the AVTRW Executive Committee.

If you would like to be considered for a bursary, please indicate so on the abstract submission form, along with the institute where you are registered. Awardees will be informed following the abstract submission deadline after abstracts have been assessed.
